

FESTIVAL REPUBLIC - CAMPERVAN & CARAVAN TERMS & CONDITIONS

As part of our terms and conditions we do not permit makeshift campervans/caravans on site at our events. Many won't have sufficient ventilation, water or door separation, and the risk from the gas and fire is an obvious one.

Festival Republic and Department for Transport definition of campervans/caravans:

- There must be a door that provides access to the living accommodation.
- A bed, which is an integral part of the living quarters which has a minimum length of 1800mm or 6 feet. This can be converted at night from seats used for other purposes during the day but must be permanently fixed within the body of the vehicle.
- There must be a water storage tank or container on or in the vehicle.
- A seating and dining area permanently attached to the vehicle. The table may be detachable but must have some permanent means of attachment to the vehicle. It's not good enough to have a loose table.
- There must be a permanently fixed means of storage, a cupboard, locker or wardrobe.
- There must be at least one window on the side of the accommodation.

Access and use of the campervan area is provided subject to the following Festival Republic Terms and Conditions (T&C's). Purchasing a permit constitutes your acceptance of these T&C'S.

These T&C'S are in addition to the main ticket T&C'S which are provided on the official website.

TICKETS/PASSES

You will first need to purchase a weekend ticket for every occupant of the campervan or caravan. Day ticket holders are not permitted access to the campervan area.

The Campervan Permit is a supplementary pass only, sold per vehicle, which needs to be clearly displayed in the windscreen of your campervan on arrival at the site.

CAMPERVAN FIELD STATE FAYRE

Please ensure you read these carefully and abide by the following:

- Trailer tents are permitted.
- There will be limited space for ONE tent OR an awning to be erected per campervan/caravan.
- There is NO water or electricity hook available. There will be a water point and waste tank in the campsite for general use.
- All waste water must be put in the containers provided. It is illegal to pour waste water onto the ground, into a sump or into a stream. This will be monitored by the Environment Agency.
- Campervan/Caravan ticket holders must use the toilets provided in the campsite and not pollute streams or hedges.
- Open fires are NOT permitted.

- Campfires and disposable barbecues are no longer allowed anywhere at the festival, including the campsites. This decision has been made in conjunction with Essex County Fire & Rescue Service, and in consideration of local impacts as set out in our Green Nation Charter. Anyone seen creating or fuelling a fire will be evicted from the festival site.

- Please always respect The Country Code.

CARS AND ARRIVAL

A windscreen routing hanger will be sent to you with your Campervan/Caravan ticket with travel directions. Please follow these directions as they will get you there quicker than your Sat Nav route. Towing vehicles must remain with the caravans, not parked elsewhere.

All vehicles other than towing vehicles must be parked in the car parks.

Can I bring my trailer tent?

Yes, as long as it is a purpose-built, manufacturer-made trailer tent.

Can I bring my roof tent?

Yes, as long as it is a purpose-built, manufacturer-made roof tent, and you bring cooking and washing facilities with it.
