- Support the Bars Supervisor and a team of up to 14 bar staff or mobile sales staff during live events
- Ensure all bars and mobile units open on time and are fully prepared for service
- Conduct event briefings, communicating key services and safety information
- Maintain speed of service, efficiency, and presentation throughout the shift
- Keep staff engaged, motivated, and focused during busy and quieter periods
- Provide on-the-floor support, ensuring staff meet venue service standards
- Address poor practice and correct in a constructive, professional manner
- Promote and drive upselling and ancillary sales across all areas
- Monitor bar and mobile stock levels throughout the shift
- Follow all licensing, responsible service, and health & safety requirements
- Record and report any operational issues promptly to the Bars Management
- Complete shift paperwork accurately and on time
- Ensure end-of-shift close-down procedures are followed to standard
- Attend staff meetings, training sessions, and pre-event briefings as required
- Maintain venue cleanliness, organisation, and equipment upkeep
- Provide shift feedback and reports to the Bars Management
- Be a positive ambassador for the venue and its live entertainment program
