



Dear Residents & Local Businesses,

We wanted to provide local residents, businesses, and the community with the details for our upcoming events taking place in on the Italian Terraces at Crystal Palace Park. Thank you for your feedback and comments throughout the planning process.

WHAT EVENTS ARE TAKING PLACE?

The Community Concert is a free event for everyone to attend, featuring performances from local schools and local musicians. More information and free ticket registration will be available on our website in the coming months.

EVENT BUILD AND BREAK: We will be on-site at the park from **16 June – 9 July 2026.**

SOUND CHECKS: Sound checks will take place on each of the event days prior to opening and may take place on Thursday 25 June and Thursday 2 July. No sound checks will take place earlier than 10:00am. Sound checks will not be at maximum event levels and although they may last over the period of an hour or two, tests will be carried out in short intervals.

ACCESS: Outside of our main site, the community will still have access to the rest of the Park, including the Brown & Green Life Café, Concert Bowl Café, Dinosaurs, Playground and the National Sports Centre (NSC). Some routes through the park will temporarily be closed during our events, and signage will be posted in the park that identifies alternative routes. We are also working with the NSC to minimise impact and disruption to visitors on live event days. For more details, please speak to the team at the National Sports Centre.

GOOD NEIGHBOURS: We want to be good neighbours, so have made arrangements for **additional cleaning** in the local area. This will take place within the park and off-site, with additional litter pickers covering a wide range of roads and streets. We have also arranged for additional toilets to be deployed in prominent areas around the park and at main transport hubs and routes.

2026 TRAFFIC PLANS – PARKING RESTRICTIONS / RESIDENT ACCESS

We have been working closely with various organisations, local authorities and emergency services with the aim to cause as little disruption as possible to residents and provide safe access and exit from the site. Traffic routes will be managed by off-site traffic co-ordinators and marshalled by an experienced traffic management company accordingly.

There is strictly no public parking at the events, and Festival Republic is clearly advising customers not to drive, and to use public transport to travel to the event. To deter attendees from parking in the local area and maintain resident and business parking, we are working with Local Authorities to implement resident access-only road closures and parking restrictions on roads in close proximity to the park. Public notices will be posted around 2 weeks prior to the first event day. The road closures will be staffed by traffic marshals and will remain accessible to residents and delivery drivers.

We will provide signage for the local area and are liaising with the Highways teams of the surrounding Boroughs to provide additional and clear signage approximately two weeks before the events on residential roads to advise of the access only road closures.

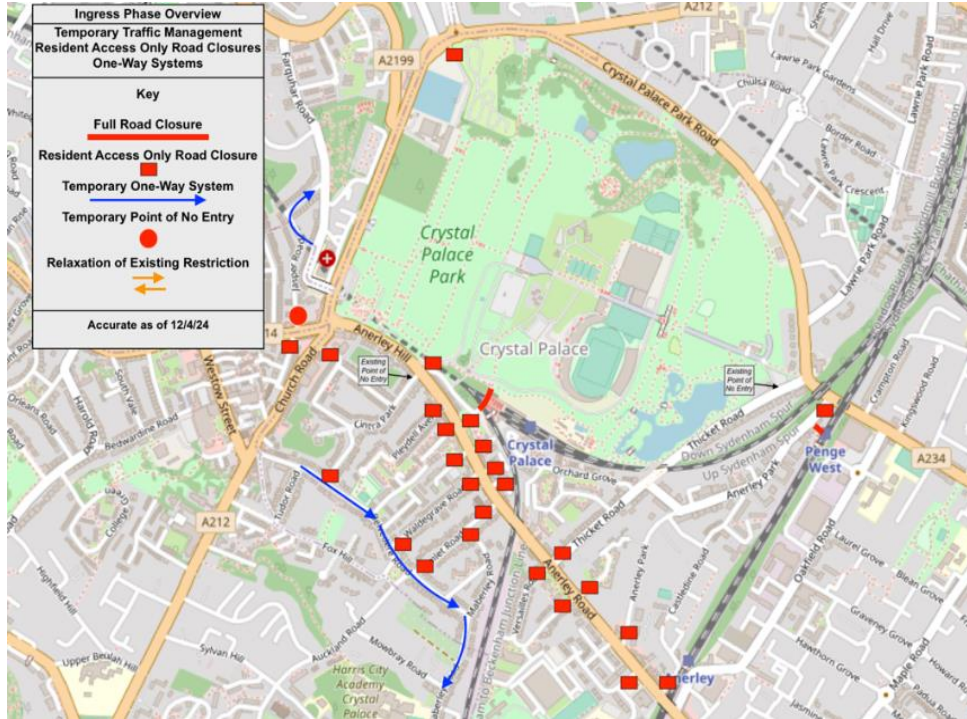
ROAD CLOSURE ACCESS

All road closure points will be staffed during the day to facilitate access for vehicles associated with residents.

We ask residents to keep **proof of ID** (driving licence or utility bill, for example) with an address in their vehicles to gain access to road closures. Enhanced briefings for stewards will be in place to ensure this process occurs. Delivery vehicles will need to show either a delivery note or proof of occupation to enter resident access-only roads. For all taxi pickups, medical home visits and personal visitors, a common-sense approach will be in place.

Residents will be able to report any access issues or to report unsafe or illegal parking to the stewarding team deployed on the road or the residents' telephone hotline and dedicated email address.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS / SUSPENSIONS

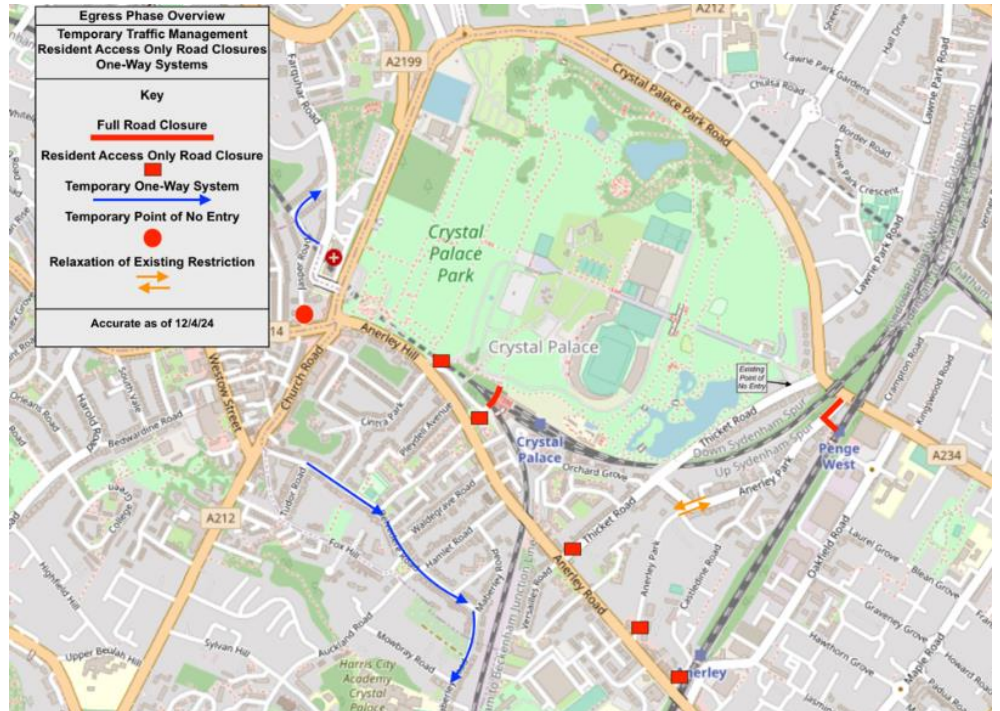
- Anerley Hill: from the junction at the top of the hill to Hadlow Place
- Crystal Palace Station Road
- Ridsdale Road: by the approach to Anerley Station.
- Anerley Park: between Penge West Station and the High Street
- The service road leading to Penge West Station
- Ledrington Road: further details of the suspensions will be posted to the affected residents closer to the events.
- Meaford Way: 150m area

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT & ROAD CLOSURES

ANERLEY HILL: There will be parking suspensions on Anerley Hill and Anerley Road, between the junction with Hadlow Place to the junction with Crystal Palace Parade. There will also be a bus stop suspension on Anerley Hill, near to the junction with Ledrington Road. **Anerley Hill will remain open to traffic in both directions.**

ANERLEY PARK: Anerley Park will be closed, from the junction with the High Street to the junction with Penge West station between 20:30hrs-23:30hrs on each event day. During these times, access for residents will be maintained via the junction with Anerley Road and Anerley Park Road.

THICKET ROAD: In accordance with the measures implemented in 2025, there will be no parking restrictions near the railway bridge, and the existing one-way restriction will remain in place. The only parking restrictions will be immediately outside the park gate (Penge Gate).

BELVEDERE ROAD: An eastbound one-way system will be implemented on Belvedere Road to promote traffic flow.

JASPER ROAD: A one-way system will be implemented on Jasper Road to promote traffic flow.

TRANSPORT

We anticipate that there will be minimal impact on public transport throughout the day due to phased arrivals although the stations may be busier than normal. The train stations nearest the event will be much busier on Friday 26 June, Saturday 27 June, Sunday 28 June, Friday 3 July and Saturday 4 July from approx. 20:30 – 00:00. We would advise people allow more time when travelling at these times. All necessary provisions will be made to facilitate access for local residents.

We are working with all taxis, Uber and Bolt to minimise the impact of collections on local residents.

SOUND MANAGEMENT

We are working with one of the UK's leading acoustic consultants, who draft and monitor our noise management plan (NMP). Following extensive discussions with Bromley's Environmental Protection Officer, we plan to maintain the same reduced sound levels as agreed in 2023. Our noise consultants will be monitoring sound levels throughout the events.

During the show or at any point in the build-up, you can report noise complaints to the Community Hotline or email address. This line will be in operation from 8:00-20:00 in the build and break phases, and 8:00-23:30 (or later if necessary) on show days. We would urge everyone to report their complaint to this number in the first instance as all calls are logged and recorded and it allows our expert noise engineers to respond quickly. It is also anticipated that there may be pyrotechnic displays on show days, please check our webpage for updates.
