



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY

Venue Management reserves the right to refuse entry, remove any person from the venue, or deny entry to any person in possession of prohibited items where necessary to maintain a safe, secure and enjoyable environment for all patrons, artists and staff.

BAG CHECKS

For the safety and comfort of all patrons, all bags may be subject to inspection upon entry to the venue. Please assist our staff by opening your bag and moving any items as requested. Venue staff will not handle personal belongings unless necessary.

ALCOHOL

Alcohol, cans, bottles and any other beverages purchased outside the venue are not permitted to be brought into the venue. Any external alcohol may be refused entry or confiscated in accordance with venue policies.

PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION & ILLEGAL DRUGS

Prescription medication may be brought into the venue where it is contained in its original packaging and clearly labelled by a pharmacist with the patron's name. Venue staff may request valid identification to verify ownership of prescription medication.

Illegal drugs, prohibited substances, and unlabelled liquid or pill medication containers are strictly prohibited and will not be permitted within the venue.

WEAPONS & DANGEROUS ITEMS

Weapons of any kind, knives, sharp objects or any item deemed dangerous by Venue Management or law enforcement are strictly prohibited.

Any dangerous or prohibited items identified during entry screening may be refused entry, confiscated or reported to Queensland Police where appropriate.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following items are not permitted within the venue:

- Weapons, including but not limited to firearms, knives, combat weapons, explosives, ammunition, pepper spray, brass knuckles, clubs, bats, heavy chains, projectiles and replica weapons.
- Illegal drugs and prohibited substances.
- Bags and containers larger than 40cm x 40cm x 20cm.



- Alcohol, cans, bottles and external food or beverages (unless required due to a medical condition and supported by appropriate evidence).
- Laser pens or pointers.
- Professional cameras and camera equipment, including tripods, detachable lenses and selfie sticks (unless authorised).
- Fireworks, flares, fire starters, open flames and other hazardous materials.
- Audio recording equipment and noise-making devices.
- Skateboards, rollerblades, hoverboards, scooters, bicycles and other personal motorised or non-motorised vehicles.
- Unauthorised drones or unmanned aerial systems (UAS).
- Animals, except assistance animals as recognised by applicable legislation.
- Banners, posters, flags, signs or any unauthorised promotional, commercial, political, religious or offensive materials, including leaflets, stickers and flyers.
- Unauthorised solicitation, selling or distribution of promotional materials.
- Any other item deemed unsafe, inappropriate or disruptive by Venue Management or law enforcement.

VENUE MANAGEMENT DISCRETION

Venue Management reserves the right to prohibit any item not specifically listed above if it is considered unsafe, disruptive, inappropriate, or likely to interfere with the enjoyment of other patrons or the safe operation of the event.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Patrons consent to the use of their image, likeness and voice captured at the venue in any medium, including without limitation, live telecast, social media, video recording or photograph for reporting, archival or promotional purposes.

Patrons are advised that the venue is fitted with electronic surveillance and patrons may be recorded for the safety and security of all visitors.

The venue is strictly a smoke-free venue, including e-cigarettes and vaping.

Patrons under 18 years must be accompanied by a responsible adult to enter the venue.

Patrons must provide government issued photo identification to enter licensed area(s) at the venue.
