### YOUR PURPOSE

To lead and support a team of bar staff, ensuring bars are well-prepared, efficiently operated, and delivering excellent customer service. You'll be responsible for maintaining speed of service, upholding venue standards, driving sales, and ensuring all licensing and safety procedures are followed.

### KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Supervise and support a team of up to 14+ bar staff during live events
- Complete pre-event checks and ensure bars are fully set up for service
- Deliver event briefings to the bar team and motivate them throughout the shift
- Ensure excellent customer service while maintaining speed and quality of service
- Train, coach, and develop bar staff to venue standards
- Encourage and monitor upselling and ancillary sales
- Maintain a clean, safe, and organised bar area — both front and back of house
- Monitor and record bar stock, waste, and recycling in line with venue procedures
- Ensure all transactions are processed correctly via card-only POS systems
- Follow and enforce responsible alcohol service and licensing laws
- Complete all post-shift tasks, ensuring bars are closed and cleaned to standard
- Liaise with Bars Management, Security, and cleaning teams throughout events
- Provide accurate and timely shift feedback and reports to the Bars Manager
- Support Green Nation sustainability procedures and recycling compliance
- Maintain professionalism under pressure and assist with problem-solving as required
